Members share their resources (time, money, experience, knowledge and expertise) for charitable purposes or public benefit and, thus, promote sustainable well-being, equity and justice for all. 3. Mission statement and vision

We envision a country where everyone has access to basic services and to opportunities needed to thrive. In a Beninese society that's ever-changing, increasingly competitive and confronted with tremendous social and environmental challenges, we work alongside Government, academia, private sector and civil society so that no one is left behind. Driven by our values, including Excellence in action, Transparency, Human flourishing (well-being and flourishing life for all), Solidarity and Sharing, we stand for a poverty and hunger- free, just and equitable, healthy, water and energy-secure, caring and environmentally-friendly society.

4. What we do

Our activity has a name: Projects and programs for better lives. Indeed, HT BENIN uses project-based approaches or strategies and works day to day, relentlessly and hard on the ground with disadvantaged people and communities across Benin to help them out of poverty, water scarcity, energy deficits, and hunger. Every year, we plan up to 10 small-scaled and medium-sized projects.

5. Key actions and achievements in the fiscal year 2022

In 2022, we reached more than usually. We implemented 14 projects and impacted 64960 people. Actions carried out in 2022 include 4 core areas: Water, education, healthcare, and employment.

62000 rural people across 8 villages (GODOGOSSOUN, RIFFO, DJAGO, ROGBANDJIN, IGOHO, ATTAKE, AMANDJI, and OKEMERE in central Benin) have been given access to clean water through 8 achieved water wells.

An ultrasound machine was purchased to improve healthcare and increase health services for 2063 rural people, in particular, children, girls and women. Jobs in sewing and photography were created for 75 beneficiaries, including girls, men and women through 3 projects of vocational integration within the commune of Abomey-Calavi, South Benin.

One school meal project was achieved for 22 children whose schooling was threatened by hunger in the city of Abomey-Calavi, South Benin.

A module of 4 classes was built to provide an opportunity for school education (basic education) to around 800 children aged 4 - 7 years in the village of KERE.

In sum, 14 out of 14 projects for 2022 were successfully carried out. So we reached an execution rate of 100%.
